GREETINGS FROM THE EAST



In October, we plan to have our regular Stated meeting - formal dress code. I have been informed by the Grand Master that he will not be making his official visit to our Lodge. He canceled all his activities through October. I would not be surprised if he extends the cancellation through November as well. However, our District Deputy R.W.B. Phil Myers plans to visit us at the October Stated meeting as a guest. That means his visit will not be an official one with a ceremony. Also, there is no dinner meeting before Lodge. At our October Stated meeting, WB Kevin Gladysz will give an educational presentation that should be of great interest.

1. All members shall wear a mask at all times while in Lodge, including when entering or departing a Lodge building.
2. Lodge Registry will be handled and recording made by Lodge Secretary.
3. Tyler will take the body temperature of all Masons entering the building.
4. Social distancing will be observed before, during, and after Lodge meetings. Additionally, while it is to be avoided during these times, should personal contact be necessary, the use of hand sanitizer will be required before and after contact.
5. All members should wear gloves (vinyl or latex only); in the absence of gloves, and in general, hand sanitizer shall be used regularly to prevent the spread of any disease.
6. If you are over 60 years old and decide to attend a Lodge meeting, you must know that you increase your risk of contracting COVID-19. Should you attend Lodge, you must wear a mask, gloves and practice social distancing
7. Members are encouraged to follow proper sanitation measures to avoid spreading or coming into contact with active viruses.
8. Members who have COVID-19 symptoms themselves or in their household or are running a fever should stay home and not attend any Lodge meetings or Masonic events.

Please remember that we will be electing new officers of the Lodge at the November Stated Meeting for 2021 (6021 A.L.). All candidates must announce their candidacy at this meeting. I encourage you to attend the meeting, and we will take all necessary measures to ensure your safety. We are doing as much as possible to keep the Lodge in good shape. Thanks to WB Dan Bush, painters started working on repainting the Lodge. The colors we chose are great.

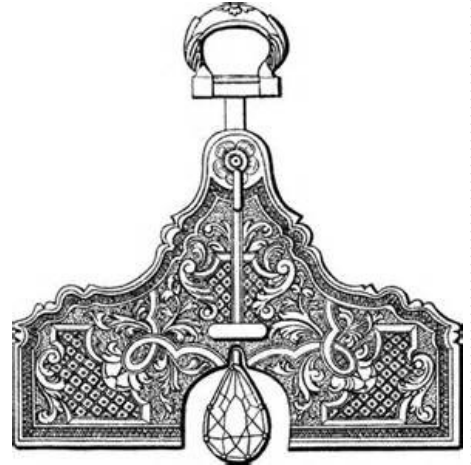
Finally, my Brothers remember your solemn obligation, and may the G.A.O.U. be with you on your Masonic journey.

We should all take great pride in the accomplishments we have made this year.

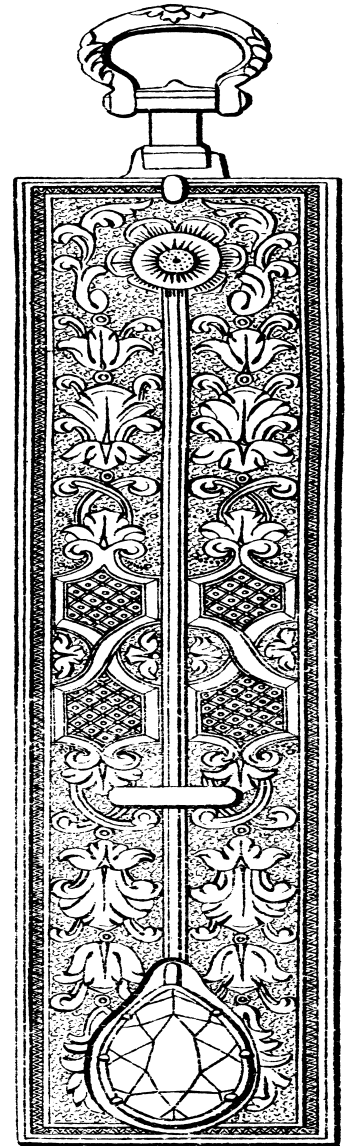
I am still optimistic we will be able to meet as a whole before the year ends.
